CSVnet and Medì Study Center presented online the research "I participate therefore I give. The solidarity engagement of people of immigrant origin beyond the pandemic."

The survey is edited by Maurizio Ambrosini and Deborah Erminio of Medì Study Center and is promoted by CSVnet, with the collaboration of Italian Volunteer Service Centers.

Three years after the first survey, dedicated mainly to foreign people's engagement in volunteering, the focus of this new study is the broader practices of giving and helping that have involved people of immigrant origin, starting with two dramatic events for our country: the Covid-19 pandemic and the reception of refugees fleeing the Russian-Ukrainian conflict.
