A food pantry run by volunteers that offers food distribution in a shop format, but most importantly offers listening, support, and educational/cultural opportunities

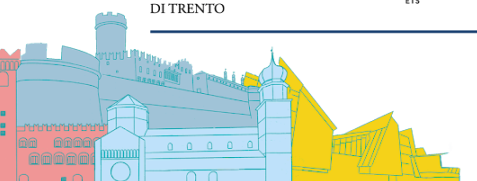
Nutrire Trento

Trentino Solidale

Trentino Solidale is a volunteer organization with a number of projects around food, poverty, and inclusion. It runs the food bank at the site we will visit. Trentino Solidale manages directly and indirectly various projects, often collaborating with other volunteer associations in its network. But all of the activities are implemented by volunteers, there are in fact around 700 member-volunteers giving their time, skills, and abilities to organize and implement projects.

Casa Orlando

A house providing living quarters and support for homeless individuals. Ex homeless volunteers provide support and mentoring.

Emporio Edera

This is a visit to a cooperative with a food store run entirely by volunteers with also social and cultural activities around food, sustainability and responsible consumption.

La Foresta e Tana dei Papà (Rovereto):

8.30 - 13.00

La Foresta Accademia di Comunità

A community space in a regenerated section of the Rovereto train station offering a variety of educational, social, and cultural activities and promoting community collaboration. The visit will touch on the regeneration of public spaces, collaboration between the Municipality and volunteer organizations, how to organize the volunteers and activities, and the range of activities and functions in the space.

La Tana dei Papà

Beni Comuni

Municipality of Trento, collaboration pacts between citizens and the Municipality

La Rete - Giardino degli Aromi

Collaboration between middle school students, La Rete social Cooperative, and the Municipality to care for a public garden located along the Fersina river. La Rete is a social cooperative working with young people and adults with disabilities.

Orto Aperto

Visit to a community garden organized under a collaboration pact with the Municipality. The experience has shown how a garden can be not only a source of healthy food, but also a concrete expression of authentic social engagement, enhancing wellbeing and generating significant relationships between volunteers.

Speck&Tech

Speck&Tech is the digital community of Trentino. Founded on March 1st, 2016 by a group of youngsters, who some people would define nerds or geeks, it was then officially registered as an “Associazione Culturale” on April 18th, 2017. Since its birth, Speck&Tech has always had an ambitious and precise goal (as one can still read in the motto on the homepage), that is to create a community of people, even very different from each other, united by a passion for technology and innovation, who want to exchange ideas and knowledge about these and related topics.

Spazio X

Visit to a library that has become a multi-functional community space. Managed by the association Noi Quartieri Trento Sud, the intent is to create an open space that values the multiethnic neighborhood, creating a space perceived as a common good, open to dialog and knowledge, and sharing of experiences.

Forno Sociale Migola, Progetto Fionda, Intrecciante 8.30 - 13.00

Forno Sociale Migola

A public bakery promoting inclusion and social cohesion. The project, curated by Carpe Diem APS in collaboration with Germogli Odv, makes informality and spontaneity its guiding principles. It aims to generate opportunities to meet, build relationships and develop the community's potential so that it can take care of itself and strengthen its capacity to be a place of inclusion. The Migola Social Bakery is a bakery that is open to all, at which it is possible to produce bread, flatbreads, and pizzas for self-consumption in a welcoming community setting. Waiting times for leavening are an opportunity to forge bonds and exchange experiences. During the activity there is an operator who takes care of the technical part, i.e., dough and baking, and an operator who takes care of the social part, facilitating relationships and enhancing participants' skills.

Progetto Fionda

A project in collaboration between multiple organizations to encourage volunteering amongst youth aged 16-20.

Intrecciante

A small practical example of inclusion and intercultural dialogue. It interweaves the stories of young people with different backgrounds and experiences, among them: young social workers, young people waiting to have their asylum applications answered, refugees, university students, local soccer players; all actively involved in the organizational process that led to the birth of this unique association in the Trentino sports scene.
